Designed to counter the prevailing notion of aging as decline, and consider the possibility of late life transformation, integrity, and transcendence.

Join us for this film-based, facilitator-led series of film viewings and discussions on the themes of elders on a quest, men and aging, women and aging, late life romance, and intergenerational issues.

Elderquest 2012 is dedicated to the memory of Charles (Chuck) Nicholas, (1938-2011). "Around his 60th birthday, Chuck embarked on an Elderquest through which he touched the lives of "third age" Americans at Lifelong Learning Institutes across the country. By helping people take time to reflect on emerging issues of positive aging in film and literature, he encouraged them to take their own journeys of self-reflection later in life.

The first session, an introduction to the Elderquest concept, will explore issues of aging and gender and late life transformation through lecture, readings, an 80-minute documentary film, and discussion. Printed course outlines will be distributed. Each of the following sessions will include an introduction, viewing of a feature film, a break, and discussion.

Elderquest 2012 films are: *Little Dieter Needs to Fly; Antonia's Line; Departures; Get Low; Small Act; Secondhand Lions; Cinema Paradiso; and The Way.*

Directions to Martin DePorres Center: Exit I-670 at 5th Avenue. Go west one block to Nelson Road and turn right (north) on Nelson. Stay in left lane on approach to light at Nelson and Airport Drive. Cross Airport Drive into St. Mary of the Springs property (through stone gate). Road winds to the left, then turn right at stop sign. The Center is second building on the right. To park, go past the Center and enter Lot B.
